

Upgrading Reading Station's links to public transport

Find out more about plans for improvements



Plans for the new southern station entrance and concourse for Reading Station were approved at planning committee last month. The new station building and facilities will extend across Station Approach and will include a large pedestrianised area, meaning the closure of Station Approach which is currently used by buses, taxis and cycles.

This means roads located around the station will need to be reconfigured with bus, taxi, cycle, coach and drop-off interchange facilities in the area reorganised.

The Council has now organised a further series of exhibitions where residents, businesses and organisations can find out more.

The dates of the exhibitions are:

Wednesday 21 October, Reading Station Forecourt, 2pm to 8pm

Wednesday 28 October, Broad Street, 11am to 5pm

Tuesday 3 November, Civic Centre, 12noon to 5pm.

Members of Reading Borough Council's transport team will be on hand to explain the changes to traffic flows around the town centre and to answer any questions from the public.
