This year's Reading Festival will take place from Friday 28th August to Sunday 30th August 2015.

A SPECIAL HOTLINE NUMBER - 0118 402 3315 has been set up for local residents' use who wish to offer comments or to raise queries during the event. The line will be answered between 9am and 5pm on Wednesday 26th August, and then 24 hours from 9am Thursday 27th until 3pm Monday 31st August. There is also an email licensing@reading.gov.uk but please note this is only staffed during RBC office hours.

The standard of noise control has been reviewed for the 2015 event and the intention is once again to avoid unreasonable disturbance to local residents.

The timetable for the event is as follows: -

There will be the following sound testing -

Thursday 27th August - 12:30 to 20:30

Friday 28th August/Saturday 29th/Sunday 30th August - 10:00 -12:00 (includes full song sound checking) Sound tests will be conducted under the direct supervision of officers from Reading Borough Council. Every effort will be made to ensure that these tests are as brief as possible and are conducted at appropriate times.

There will be stage effects, which may emit a short series of loud bangs on the Radio 1 NME Stage on Friday 28th between 22:40 and 23:30, Saturday 29th from 21:10 to 22:00 and on Main Stage on Sunday 30th between 20:00 and 21:10, and again between 23:00 - 23:30.
