

# Public Meeting

## Tuesday 17 June 7.30 pm, St Andrew's Hall about the permanent location secured for *The Heights Primary School*

The meeting, hosted by Cllr Isobel Ballsdon and Cllr Ed Hopper, is to enable local residents to give views in light of the news that the Education Funding Agency (EFA) has purchased a site for *The Heights* primary school's permanent home.

On 5<sup>th</sup> June *The Heights* was able to announce that the EFA has purchased a privately owned development site known as 'Highridge' on Upper Warren Avenue. This is a key milestone for the establishment of the school but plans are yet to be drawn up. These will come together over the next few months, with the formal consultation and planning processes taking place later in the year.

In the meantime *The Heights* is set to open in September in temporary accommodation off Gosbrook Road at the old Caversham Nursery site.

Dan Pagella, Head Teacher Karen Edwards and other members of *The Heights* team will be in attendance as will Kevin McDaniel, Head of Education at Reading Borough Council.
