

**230313 - 5G Mast a Junction of Henley Road and Donegal Close
Appeal APP/E0345/W/23/3327407 Statement**

The views along that part of the Henley Road and at the site (opposite Donegal Close) are pleasant, with an open aspect across Queen Anne's School recreation ground, only interrupted by a few slender streetlights and the occasional small tree. The mast proposed is much wider and higher than the streetlights, which do not have any associated pavement cabinets. The current street scene helps to offset some of the traffic's impact on this busy main route for residents and passers-by. The proposed mast would significantly worsen that. No alternative sites were considered or opportunities to share masts with other telecom providers. We ask for the appeal to be dismissed.

Comment on original application to RBC

The site of the proposed mast is by Queen Annes School. The mast would dominate the street scene, towering over neighbouring properties. Alternative, more innovative solutions should be examined
