Reading Borough Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to 3, 4(2), and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under the provisions of Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 intends to make an Order the effects of which are: To introduce, remove or amend existing waiting restrictions and parking places either in the interests of safety or in response to demand. This has necessitated changing or revising existing Traffic Orders.

Chester Street, South Side: Introduce 'no waiting at any time' from a point 14m west of its junction with Prospect Street to a point 18m northwest of that point.

Priory Avenue, West Side: Introduce 'no waiting at any time' from a point 29m north of its junction with Church Street to a point 28m north of that point.

Westfield Road, West Side: Introduce 'no waiting at any time' from a point 54m south of its junction with Prospect Street to a point 19m south of that point.

Marsack Street, North Side: Introduce 'no waiting at any time' from a point 5m west of its junction with South View Park to a point 5m east of that junction.
